HPSS SUPERANNUATION EMPLOYER CIRCULAR

GENERAL MEDICAL PRACTITIONER INTERIM DYNAMISING FACTORS FOR FINANCIAL YEAR 2005 - 2006

HSS(S) Circular 8/2005 included details of the interim General Medical Practitioner (GMP) Dynamising Factors (DF) for 2003/04 and 2004/05. The final medical DFs for 2003/04 and 2004/05 will be notified as soon as possible. Meanwhile, Annex 1 to this Circular contains the interim medical DF for 2005/06.

The interim factors for GMPs do NOT apply to General Dental Practitioners (GDPs).

The dental DFs have yet to be agreed for year 2005 /06. The relevant figure and tables will be notified as soon as possible in a future Circular.

Appendix A: Interim General Medical Practitioner Uprating (Dynamising) Factors for 2005/06

1. Interim increase for 2005/06

The interim increase for the year ending 31 March 2006 has been agreed as follows:

General Medical Practitioners	1 April 2005 to 31 March 2006	7.3%

2. Uprating pay to dates between 1 April 2005 to 28 February 2006 inclusive

To uprate a General Medical Practitioner's (GMP) pay to any date from 1 April 2005 to 28 February 2006, the following action should be taken:

- a) The pay for each year up to and including 31 March 2005 should first be multiplied by the factor given in this circular Annex 1, Appendix B.
- b) The total of these uprated amounts should then be increased by the appropriate percentage shown in Annex 1, Appendix C to this letter.
- c) Any pay that is paid on or after 1 April 2005 should then be added to the uprated pay figure from b) above, to provide the full pensionable pay for benefit purposes.

3. Uprating pay to dates between 1 March 2006 to 31 March 2006 inclusive

To uprate pay to any date between 1 March 2006 and 31 March 2006, the pay for each year should be increased by the relevant factor for that year shown in Appendix B to this Annex.
