

Draft Smoke-free Regulations 2007 – E-Consultation on-line response

Q1: YES

Q2a: An additional sign should be displayed to state that it is against the law to smoke in the vehicle – as in smoke-free premises, as the no smoking symbol alone is a currently used symbol, and in order to emphasize the change in status to a legal requirement for non-smoking.
