Firstly, I would like to thank you for the opportunity to respond to the consultation and on behalf of my organisation, to congratulate the Department of Health, Social Services and Public Safety on a well-involved process and the delivery of a comprehensive and well-read document.

This organisation endorses the thrust of the strategy that improving the health of the population has a major impact on us all, irrespective of our role in society. We acknowledge that the causes of poor health and health inequalities are directly linked to the wider determinants of health, of which we all must contribute a role in tackling. We welcome the direction of the strategy in that it sees a clear vision for the future, with a major emphasis on investing for health and wellbeing.
